Guy Leland Hernan, 69, of Mason City passed away on May 19, 2020 at 6:17 pm at his home. He was born on July 5, 1950 in Springfield to Leland and Doris “June” (Fletcher) Hernan. He married Renee Chambers on June 24, 1985 in Las Vegas.

Guy Lee is survived by Renee and 5 children: Jason Chambers, Dani Hernan, Billy (Alicia) Hernan, James (Sarah) Hernan and Jeff (Emily) Hernan, 8 grandchildren and 3 sisters: Lois Stewart, Luanne Cave, Jule Dragstrem and his brother Jim Hernan. He was preceded in death by his parents.

He served in the United States Army, was a member of the United Presbyterian Church of Mason City, enjoyed traveling, volunteering and the restoring of the Marbold Farmstead in Greenview.
