Halbert L. "Hab" Campbell, 88, of Havana passed away peacefully with his family beside him after a brief battle with lung cancer at 6:32 a.m. on Friday, March 22, 2019 at his home. He was born on December 31, 1930 in Hamilton County to John and Mary (Hargrove) Campbell. He married Betty Lewis on October 29, 1955 in Mt. Vernon, Illinois. She survives.
