Harold V. Baker, 90, passed away March 9, 2018, at Sarah Bush Lincoln Health Center. He was born on July 3, 1927 in Mason County, Illinois, the son of Ernest and Ina (Sarff) Baker. He married Elizabeth "Betty" Schilling, at Havana, on December 12, 1947. She survives.

Mr. Baker was a rural mail carrier and Postmaster at Kilbourne and Ashland, Illinois for 35 years. He owned and operated Baker Service. He was a WWII US Navy Veteran and later served in the US Navy Reserves for 19 years. He enjoyed serving his community on several elected and volunteer committees and boards. He was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Havana.
