Manito—Harold Edwin Thompson, 86, of 107 Market St. Manito passed away Thursday, February 21, 2013 at Pekin Hospital. He was born January 18, 1927 in Quiver Twp. near Havana the son of John E. and Mary Stroud Thompson. He married Donna J. Singley on July 19th 1947 in Peoria and she survives. Also surviving are one daughter Rebecca Switzer of Manito; one son Eric (Anna Marie) Thompson of Orlando, Florida; two grandchildren Dr. Erika (Jason) Switzer-Hunter and John C. Thompson of Orlando, Florida; two great grandsons Wilson Thompson Hunter and Jakob Dean Hunter both of Manito. One brother William Thompson preceded him in death.

Harold was a WWII Marine Corp Veteran enlisting in 1945 after graduating from high school. He served in North China at the end of WWII and belonged to the China Marine Association. He was a member and past post commander of the Hill-Palmer American Legion Post #461 in Manito.

He owned and operated businesses in Manito for several years; served as the Village of Manito Justice of the Peace until that office was no longer in effect. He served twenty four years on the Mason Co. Board of Supervisors retiring in 2002; served on the Meadow Lawn Cemetery Board; a Mason Co Republican precinct committeeman in Manito for many years and was a member of the Community United Methodist Church in Manito.

There will be no visitation. Cremation rites will be accorded. A private inurnment of his cremains will be held at a later date at Meadow Lawn Cemetery in Manito.
