



## Harold Wayne Webb

May 17, 1948 - March 19, 2021

Harold Wayne Webb, 72, of Manito, passed away at his home at 3:52 p.m., on Friday, March 19, 2021. He was born May 17, 1948, in Paragould, Arkansas, to Harrison and Letha (Tucker) Webb. He married Patricia Pollard on August 15, 1969, in Pekin, Illinois. She survives.

Mr. Webb is survived by his wife, Patricia, of Manito; four children: Tammy Lawson, of Manito, Jeff Webb, of Manito, Tim (Lora) Webb, of Delavan, and Mindy (Kevin) Rademacker, of Green Valley; thirteen grandchildren: Maddy and Jake Lawson, Tanner, Mikayla and Teagan Webb, Elijah, Rebekah, Marcus, Anna, Thomas, and Zyaire Webb, and Gabrielle and Gracie Redemacker.
