Helen L. Browning, 90, of Springfield, IL died on Monday, June 11, 2007 at 10:25 am at Capitol Care Center in Springfield. She was born on March 25, 1917 in Farmington to Carl and Clara Schulz Zessin. She married A.J. Browning in Springfield on March 25, 1935.
