Henry Lloyd Stelter, 93, of Muncie, Indiana formerly of Havana, Illinois passed away at Bethel Point Nursing Home in Muncie on Saturday, June 22, 2013. He was born on December 10, 1919 in Havana to Henry and Hannah (Wallbaum) Stelter. For many years he was married to Colleen Chambers who preceded him in death in 1996. Henry was in the Navy from 1942-1946 and was a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Havana. Henry was a sports official from 1943 -1973 officiating basketball, baseball and football, from 1949-1979 he was part owner of Kar-Stel Chevrolet Dealership in Havana. He was a 67 year member of the American Legion and served 16,000 hours of volunteer work for Ball Memorial hospital which is now Indiana University Hospital.
