Herbert R. Saathoff, 95, of Havana, passed away at 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, September 11, 2013 at Havana HealthCare Center. He was born April 7, 1918 in Rantoul, IL to Henry and Justina (Saathoff) Sathoff. He married Betty Rairdon on July 31, 1941 in Palmyra, MO.
