Howard A. Showalter, 96, of Havana passed away at Red Oak Estates in Canton at 2:22 a.m. on Monday, September 22, 2014. He was born September 15, 1918 in Havana to Phinis and Essie (Lane) Showalter. He married Suzuko "Suzy" Onishi on October 12, 1953 in Sasebo, Japan. She predeceased him in death on May 23, 2012.
