Ida Bernice Gum, 89, of Tallula, died on Monday, August 11, 2008 at 2:55 p.m. at St. John's Hospital in Springfield. She was born on June 2, 1919 in Tallula to Luther and Dolly Sutherd LeMar. She married Floyd Hinds in 1943. They operated Hinds Café for 13 years. She later married Allen Gum in 1957. He preceded her in death in 1975.

She is survived by two sons, Gary (Carole) Hinds of Springfield, Kenneth (Cheryl) Gum of Petersburg; a stepson, Thomas A. (Betty) Gum of Springfield; a step daughter, Anna B. Smith of Florida; five grandchildren; three great grandchildren; one brother, William (Virginia) LeMar of Petersburg; and a sister, Lena R. Smith of Springfield.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, one brother, one half brother, four half sisters, and a stepdaughter.

She had worked as Executive Secretary from 1961 to 1973 for Menard and Sangamon County Selective Service System. She then worked at Internal Revenue Service in Springfield from 1974 until retiring in 1985. She was a member of the Tallula Christian Church, serving as the financial secretary for 35 years. She was also treasurer for Tallula Senior Citizens and Tallula American Legion Auxiliary since 1985.
