Ida Harriet Spangler, 100 formerly of Mason City died at 3:24pm, Tuesday February 24, 2009 at the Memorial Medical Center in Springfield. She was born October 29, 1908 in Emden, the daughter of Cyrus and Anna (Zimmer) McCormick. She married Edward Spangler May 4, 1932.

Survivors are many nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews, and great-great nieces and nephews. Mrs. Spangler is preceded in death by her husband, three sisters and two brothers.

Mrs. Spangler graduated Hartsburg High School and later, Lincoln College with a certificate in teaching. She taught school for 36 years before retiring. She taught Emden grade school for six years until she married Edward, then was not allowed to teach again until during the war when there was a shortage of teachers. She also taught at Prairie Creek and New Holland schools. Mrs. Spangler was an avid Illini and Cub fan; she also enjoyed her nephews and great nephew's baseball and basketball games.
