James Brown, 79, of Topeka, Illinois, passed away peacefully at his residence surrounded by his loving family, Wednesday evening, March 1, 2023. He was born November 23, 1943 in Salem, Indiana, to the late Bruce and Hilda Akers Brown. He married Judy Callis on November 23, 1970 in Peoria, Illinois. She survives. James's parents died while he was young and his Aunt and Uncle, Fern and Frank Knight raised him to adulthood.

He worked at Caterpillar as a Machinist until he retired in 1995. He then taught math at I.C.C. for two years. In his spare time James loved working on small engines.
