



## Fr. James H. Fedosuk

November 30, 1931 - May 9, 2017

Fr. James H. Fedosuk, 85, of Havana, passed away at OSF-St. Francis Medical Center in Peoria at 4:05 p.m. on Tuesday, May 9, 2017. He was born November 30, 1931 in Hillsdale, Michigan to George and Mary Elizabeth (Hite) Fedosuk.

Fr. Fedosuk is survived by four nieces: Denise Lehrke, Eva Carroll, Mary Taylor and Kathy Bell, as well as one nephew, Ivan Fedosuk. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, George Charles Fedosuk, Ivan Fedosuk and two sisters, Katherine Elizabeth Dillinger and Ann Fuller.

Fr. Fedosuk graduated from Bradley University in Peoria. He later received his Masters Degree at Nashotah House Seminary in Wisconsin. He served as Resident Priest in the Diocese of Springfield and Quincy, serving Trinity Church - Rock Island, St. Barnabas Episcopal Church in Havana and St. James Episcopal Church in Lewistown. He was a member of the Oblate of Order of St. Benedict. Recently, he had retired from his position as Trustee for the Havana Library Board.

Visitation will be held at Hurley Funeral Home in Havana on Thursday, May 11, 2017 from 5:00 until 7:00 p.m. Funeral mass will be held at St. James Episcopal Church in Lewistown at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, May 12, 2017 with an additional hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will follow the services

at Laurel Hill Cemetery in Havana.

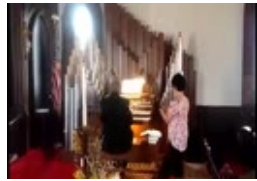
