Fulton-Mason-Peoria-Tazewell Unit Extension Council as well as the 4-H Expansion and Review

Committee. He will be remembered for his many years of service and for his commitment to

helping youth grow in their knowledge of agriculture. Jamey was a friend to everyone he knew

and will be missed by many.

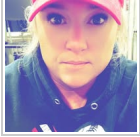
