James E. Lynn, 79, of Easton, passed away at Memorial Medical Center, in Springfield, at 7:43 p.m., on Wednesday, February 3, 2021. He was born July 15, 1941, in Lincoln, Illinois, to Addison and Gladys (Riggins) Lynn. He married Mary Miller on October 9, 1960. She survives.

Mr. Lynn is survived by his wife, Mary, of Easton; two children: Sharon (David) Wananaker, of Springfield, Illinois, Sandra Lynn, of Easton; three grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; and one great-great-grandchild. 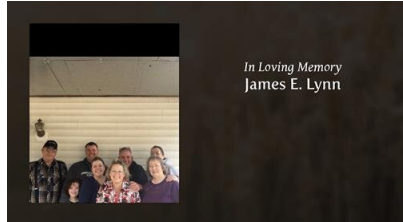

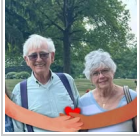
