



## Jane A. Hollis

Jane A. Hollis, 91, of Petersburg, passed away on December 5, 2016, at Sunny Acres Nursing Home in Petersburg.

Jane was born on June 20, 1925, in Greenview, IL, the daughter of the late Daniel W. and Maude (May) Austin. She was the youngest of 5 children. She married John H. Hollis on February 22, 1947. They shared 63 years of marriage until he preceded her in death on October 7, 2010.

She was also preceded in death by her parents, 3 sisters: Kathleen Vincent, Wilma Jansen, Annabelle Olson, a brother Daniel Austin, a grandson Justin Leach, and several nieces and nephews.

with a RN degree. She worked at the Menard Medical Clinic in Petersburg for 20 years and Sunny Acres Nursing Home for 5 years. She formerly owned and operated Hollis Hobbies and also worked at The Peddlers Craft and Antiques shop in Petersburg for 17 years.

A memorial service will be held on Tuesday, December 13, 2016 at 11 am at the Central Presbyterian Church in Petersburg. Pastor Diane Nolley will be officiating.
