



## Janet K. Scheina

Janet Kay Scheina, 76, of Petersburg, Illinois, passed away peacefully August 30, 2024, at St. John's Hospital in Springfield, Illinois.

She was born March 24, 1948, to Dean and Lorraine (L. Jenkins) Martin in Watseka, Illinois. She earned her bachelor's degree from Illinois State University. Janet's teaching career began in 1970 teaching at Oakford Elementary School and ended with her retiring in 2004 at Talulla Elementary School, all within the PORTA School system. Janet was well-known within the Central Presbyterian Church in Petersburg. Not only as a lifelong member, but also as an Elder, a Deacon, a Sunday School and Vacation Bible School Teacher, the founder for Coats for Kids where she would take children in need out shopping for a winter coat, the organizer for the children's Christmas programs, and a pillar within her community.
