Jay Dean Justice, 49, of Kilbourne, passed away at his home at 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 30, 2016. He was born December 6, 1966 in Springfield, IL to Terry and Sherry (Whitehead) Justice.

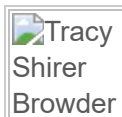

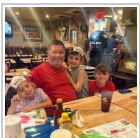

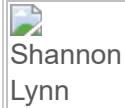
