



## Jesse (Jack) L. Dodson

April 20, 1951 - October 18, 2015

Jesse (Jack) L. Dodson Jr, 64, of San Jose passed away at his home on October 18, 2015. He was the son of Jack and Betty (Tomlinson) Dodson, who preceded him in death. He was born on April 20, 1951 in Springfield, Illinois and is survived by four daughters: Jennifer, Joy, Jeana and Danielle. He had been married three times. Also surviving are his sister: Betty Connelly of Springfield, and two brothers: Jerry (Marcia) Dodson of East Peoria and John (Cindy) Dodson of Mason City.

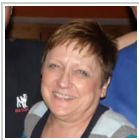

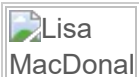
