



## Jimmie L. Weaver

Jimmie L. Weaver, 81, of Havana passed away on Father's Day, Sunday, June 19, 2016 at Heartland Health Care Center in Canton at 11:37 AM. He was born on August 26, 1934 in Idalia Missouri to Delbert and Velma (Tate) Weaver. On September 1, 1961 in Lewistown he married Dorothy Dutton who survives.

Jimmie is survived by 2 sons: JD (Sherilyn) Weaver of Havana and John (Megan) Weaver of Havana, 3 grandsons: Nicholas, Dylan and Jayden and sister Luella Pedigo of Horicon WI. He was preceded in death by his parents, brother Charles T. "Bud" Weaver and sister Margaret Jean Rawley.
