February 1, 1944 - November 22, 2018

John Gilman Lozier died suddenly at his home on November 22, 2018. He was 74.

Survivors include his wife Judy (Queenie) of 31 years; his step daughters, Julie Valier and Jane Bensel, and step son, Jay (Kim) Westervelt; his step grandchildren, Henry and John Valier, Kate and Nelson Bensel, and Thomas, Elizabeth, and Ellen Westervelt.

He was born in Anamosa, IA on February 1, 1944 to Delores and Gilman Lozier. He attended Anamosa High School and graduated in 1962. He then attended Wentworth Military Academy in Missouri for two years and graduated from Iowa State University in 1966. He began farming with his grandfather, John Hubly, in Menard County, Illinois in 1967 and farmed for 54 years, until his death.

He was a member of the Greenview Masonic Lodge, Logan County Shrine Club, and had been a member of Royal Order of Jesters Court No. 20 of Springfield, Illinois.

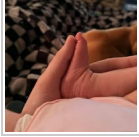
