John William Wallace, 74, of Havana, passed away at Unity Point – Methodist in Peoria, at 1:07 a.m. on Thursday, April 27, 2017. He was born April 3, 1943 in Lincoln, IL to William Benton “Cuddy” and Vernice Henrietta Augusta (Oest) Wallace. He married Arminda “Mindy” Lippert on March 23, 1963 in Havana. Mr. Wallace is survived by his wife of 54 years, Mindy, two daughters, Stacey Wallace and Melissa Wallace, all of Havana, three grandchildren, Alysia (Nick) Atwood, Samuel (Allison) Sanguedolce and Nathan Budke. Also surviving is one brother, Lynn (Linda) Wallace of Greenview. He was preceded in death by his parents and grandparents, including John I. and Lota Mae Wallace, who helped to raise him.

Mr. Wallace retired from Illinois Power / Dynegy in Havana after 41 years, working most recently as the Supervisor of the coal yard. He was a hardworking man who started working at the age of eight years old. His life was dedicated to his family.
