LaVeta Celementine Crabtree, age 90, a resident of Havana Health Care in Havana, Illinois, died at 9:00 p.m. Friday evening at her residence. She was born December 22, 1917 in Hancock, Iowa, the daughter of John G. and Anna Alice {Young} Fouts. She later married Philip B. Crabtree August 11, 1947 in Seneca, Illinois. He preceded her in death June 21, 1986.

LaVeta had taught school for a total of 33 years, having taught in the country schools in Mason and Fulton Counties in Illinois. And also taught in Ottawa, Atkins, Illinois, and retire from teaching in 1977 from Fourth Grade in Havana.

She was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Havana , and a member of the Mason County, the Illinois and National Retired Teachers Association. She had also been a member of the Alpha Delta Kappa Sorority.
