Leon F. Rowe, 92, of Havana, passed away at his home at 11:53 a.m. on Friday, April 25, 2014. He was born July 29, 1921 in Bernadotte, IL to Charles Edward and Evelyn Melissa (Smith) Rowe. He married Sylvia Friedrich on September 4, 1949 at her parent's house in Buzzville, IL.

Mr. Rowe is survived by his wife, Sylvia, of Havana, one brother, Charles E. (Doris) Rowe, Jr., of Lewistown and several nieces, nephews and brother and sister-in-laws. He was preceded in death by his parents and one twin sister Leona May (Ray) Lasswell.
