Leona May Bradley, 78, of Havana, passed away at Memorial Medical Center, in Springfield, at 2:15 a.m., on Wednesday, June 1, 2022. She was born October 6, 1943, in Lincoln, Illinois, to Edward and Erma (Lovekamp) Osing. She married Jack Hall, who preceded her in death. She later married Jack Bradley, and who also preceded her in death.
