Bath, IL - Leslie W. Lippert, 88, Quincy, IL formerly of Bath, IL died April 9, 2007 at the Illinois Veterans Home. He was born Aug,17, 1918 in Bath, the son of Charles E. And Edith Groff Lippert. He married Helen Lucille Blakeley in 1955 in Havana; she died in 1984. He was preceded in death by a sister, Arlene Bohm in 1994.

Mr. Lippert was the Bath Rural Letter Carrier for the United States Postal Service for 30 years until his retirement in 1980. He also served as Camp Secretary for Modern Woodman of America Insurance. He was a US Army Veteran of WWII, receiving a Purple Heart. He served in Iceland, Great Britain, France and Germany for nearly 5 years until his honorable discharge in 1945. He was a member of Bath United Methodist Church, Masonic Lodge #724 AF & AM of Chandlerville where he was a Past Master, American Legion Post 694 of Chandlerville, member and past President of AARP, Havana Chapter. He also served on the Bath Rural Fire Department Board of Trustees and the Central Illinois Economic Development Corporation Board.

Survivors: a son, David (wife: Lisa) Lippert of Chatham; two grandchildren, Alex Lippert and Katie Lippert of Chatham; a brother, Charles Lippert of Danville, several nieces, nephews and cousins.
