Lillian Pauline Brown Russell, 88, of Havana, passed away at St. John's Hospital in Springfield at 2:13 a.m. on Thursday, December 11, 2014. She was born January 30, 1926 in Galconda, IL to Doska N. and Nettie Pearl (Bogard) Brown. She married Kenneth Claude Russell on April 5, 1952. He preceded her in death on December 5, 1998.

Mrs. Russell is survived by three brothers, Roger (C.J.) Brown of Petersburg, Roy (Judie) Brown of Chattanooga, TN, Robert (Sandy) Brown of Mt. Vernon, IN and several cousins in Arkansas and Florida. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband and one infant daughter.

Mrs. Russell was of the Episcopal faith. She received a Bachelor of Sciences in Medical Technology from Wayne State University in 1957.
