Linda Kay Behrends, 73, of Havana, passed away at Havana Health Care at 6:16 p.m. on Tuesday, July 3, 2018. She was born September 14, 1944 in Vincennes, Indiana, to Boyd and Cliffa (Fielden) Sizemore. She married Robert W. Behrends at St. Paul's Lutheran Church on June 14, 1969. He preceded her in death on December 16, 2012.

Mrs. Behrends is survived by one son, William "Bill" (Amber) Behrends of Savoy, IL; two grandchildren: Maya and Max Behrends, of Savoy; one brother, Gene (Helen) Sizemore of Arlington, VA and one sister, Carol (Vern) Yeter of Arizona.
