



## Lloyd Davis Buttry

May 19, 1927 - November 7, 2016

Lloyd Davis Buttry passed away on Monday, November 07, 2016 at the age of 89. He resided in Petersburg, IL and is survived by his wife of 63 years, Darlene Faye (Sassman) Buttry; his five children Michael, Carol, Gene, Linda, Janet as well as 7 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren, 1 great-great grandchild and his sister, Florence Schmidt.

He was predeceased by 3 brothers, 3 sisters, one daughter, Peggy (Buttry) Ball, and one granddaughter, Katrina Faye (Boyer) Greving.

Lloyd retired from U.S. Navy as a Chief Warrant Officer 2nd Class after more than 20 years which included service during World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. He primarily served in the submarine fleet and was one of the first sailors to serve on the first nuclear submarine, the USS Nautilus.

He was a lifelong Cub's Fan and avid stamp collector.
