



## Lloyd E. Conklin

June 24, 1918 - May 16, 2007

Lloyd E. Conklin, 88, of Havana died at Mason District Hospital in Havana at 2:45 p.m on Wednesday, May 16, 2007. He was born June 24, 1918 in Kilbourne, IL to Leslie and Flossie (Ade) Conklin. He married Lora Mae Blessman September 14, 1943 in Milwaukee, WI.

Mr .Conklin is survived by his wife Lora of Havana, one son Michael (Illa) Conklin of Peoria, three grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. He is also survived by four sisters: Evelyn Williamson of Milwaukee, WI, Nina Patrick of Bath, Daisey Emmons of Alton, IL, and Patsy Kramer of Bloomington,IL; and one brother James Conklin of Petersburg.
