February 14, 1924 - September 17, 2013

Louis Dale Maxson of Mason City entered into his rest Monday, September 17, 2012 at Mason City Area Nursing Home, where he had resided several years.

He was born February 4, 1924 to Noble and Violet Maxson in Arkansas City, Kansas. In high school he worked for the Santa Fe Railroad until the bombing of Pearl Harbor prompted him to enlist in the U.S. Army. He was discharged in 1946 as a First Lieutenant.

He married Patricia Stanley on March 3, 1945 in New Orleans, LA. She and two of their sons, Louis Stanley Maxson and Mark Timothy Maxson, preceded him in death.

He is survived by sons Earle "Andy" Maxson of Petersburg and John (Gaye) Maxson of Mason City, daughters, Sara "Sally" (Butch) Steele of Oklahoma City and Rebecca "Becky" (Matt) Billingsley of Myrtle Beach, SC, and brothers, Orwin Maxson (Joanne) of Ponca City, OK and Rodney Maxson (Millie) of Midland, TX. He is also survived by 10 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren.

Louis spent his career in the rendering business, culminating in a senior management position with National By-Products, Inc. in Mason City. He was

an active member of Trinity Episcopal Church, Lincoln, and after retirement enjoyed golf, gardening and giving away many woodworking items he made. In his final act of generosity, his body was donated for medical research.
