



## Marguerite Bernice Frye

October 14, 1921 - February 14, 2017

Marguerite Bernice Frye, 95 of Hopedale, formerly of rural Havana and Easton, passed away at 11:24 AM on Tuesday, February 14 at Hopedale Nursing Home in Hopedale, IL.

She was born in rural Delavan on October 14, 1921 to John C. and Augusta Handke Moehring. She married Delbert H. Frye on March 24, 1946 at St. Luke's Lutheran Church, Allen's Grove.

Surviving are two daughters Joyce (Michael) Behrens of Galesburg and Janice (David) Kinsinger of Morton and one son, Jay (Noreen) Frye of Easton, five grandchildren, Katie (Travis) Hansen, Kyle (Faith) Kinsinger, Landon Frye, Logan Frye, Lucas Frye and three great grandchildren, Charlie, Maeve and Amos Kinsinger.
