Mary Sue Huffman, 77, of Edinburgh, formerly of Chandlerville, passed away at St. John's Hospital in Springfield at 8:05 a.m. on Thursday, February 8, 2018. She was born June 9, 1940, at home in rural Virginia, IL, to Elmer M. and Opal McKinley Houston. She married Thomas Duckwiler Huffman at St. Barnabas Episcopal Church in Havana on August 13, 1960. He preceded her in death on January 3, 1982.

Mrs. Huffman is survived by two sons: John Thomas (Becky) Huffman of Virden, IL, Matthew Huffman of Kincaid, IL; daughter, Rachel (Clay) Davidson, of Edinburgh, IL; three grandchildren: T.J. Henn, Caly Davidson and Ryleigh Davidson; as well as three siblings: Tim Houston of Chandlerville, Kay (Jerry) DeFord of Bath and Dan (Cheryl) Houston of Manito. She was preceded in death by her parents and husband.

Mrs. Huffman was raised in the Sangamon Valley Presbyterian Church, near Chandlerville and had recently attended services and bible study at First United Methodist Church in Springfield. She attended Hickory School and was a graduate of Chandlerville High School. She worked for the Illinois Secretary of State as a clerk for many years, before her retirement. She enjoyed sewing, ceramics, playing the piano and organ, and watching Property Brothers on HGTV. She was well known for her "blunt honesty."
