Melvin August “Bud” Schoneweis, 87, of Petersburg, IL passed away on Friday, September 29, 2023, at Sunny Acres Nursing Home in Petersburg. He was born on August 2, 1936, in Springfield, IL to Harvey and Juhl (Woodrum) Schoneweis. He married Suzanne Rieken on June 19, 1955, in Pleasant Plains, IL.

happiest in life was sharing the sweet corn he harvested with his friends, family, and community. He enjoyed golfing at Virginia Country Club with his friends from Cass County and enjoyed participating in many late night card games with them, and dinners with his friends.

Bud's love for horses began as a child and the passion continued as he became a member of the US Trotting Association, as well as the Illinois Harness Horsemen Association. In 2003, he began a new adventure with his sister-in-law Carol Rieken in harness racing and later with a friend and co-owner, Lyle E. Lipe. He always enjoyed watching his own horses (especially Fox Valley Langley) compete, particularly when they won.
