Milo H. Vogt, 84, of Petersburg passed away on Wednesday, June 13, 2012 at his residence. He was born August 17, 1927 in Petersburg to Milo F. and Willi (Henderson) Vogt. He married Mary Lemon on September 25, 1948. She preceded him in death on April 9, 2012.

He is survived by two sons, Milo "Miff" (Vicki) Vogt of Petersburg and John (Theresa) Vogt of Los Angeles, CA, a daughter, Cindy Vogt of Petersburg; four grandchildren, Lindsay (Shawn) Wilken, Noah Lane, Brian Vogt, and Katia Vogt, and four great grandchildren, Ally and Chelsea Wilken and Trinity and Maddie Lane. He was preceded in death by his wife, his parents, and brother, Stephen B. Vogt.

Milo served as past president and current CEO of his 75 year old family owned business, Petersburg Plumbing and Heating Co., Inc. For more than 60 years, he was active in numerous business related organizations, including the Mechanical Contractors Association of Central Illinois, Illinois Mechanical and Specialty Contractors Association, and Central Illinois Builders of AGC. He was also a longtime member of the Plumbers and Steamfitters Local 137 and served on the Board of Directors of the former First National Bank of Petersburg. He served in the Navy reserve.

Locally, he was one of a small number of businessmen responsible for the

research, development and construction oversight of Lake Petersburg in the early 1960's. He served on the Lake Association Board for many years.

He enjoyed duck hunting and golf. He was a long time member of the Shambole Golf Club and Illini Country Club.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, June 21, 2012 at 11:00 a.m. at Hurley Funeral Home in Petersburg with Pastor John Vidakovich officiating.
