Morris L. Bell, 98, of Chandlerville passed away on 12:15 a.m. on Monday, June 13, 2022 at Passavant Hospital in Jacksonville. He was born on February 21, 1924 in Saidora, Illinois to Arthur O. and Hortense (Dadisman) Bell. He married Doris L. Schaub on March 14, 1948 in Mason City, Illinois. She preceded him in death on November 27, 2016.

Mr. Bell is survived by three daughters: Rosanne (Darell) Sarff of Chandlerville, Kristine (Dennis) Lane of Lawrence, Kansas, and Lori (Steve) Turner of Chandlerville, nine grandchildren, thirteen great-grandchildren, and three great-great grandchildren.
