Nancy Ann Mangold, 75, of Springfield, passed away at Memorial Medical Center in Springfield, at 2:14 a.m. on Wednesday, February 12, 2020. She was born July 12, 1944, in Atterberry, Illinois, to Ben and Christina (Nissen) Eilks. She married Clyde A. Dearing on October 28, 1962. He preceded her in death on October 10, 1987. She later married Harold "Bill" Mangold on December 3, 2006, in Sherman, Illinois. He survives.

Nancy is survived by her husband, Bill, of Springfield; two children: Julie Ann (Dan) Atterberry, of O'Fallon, IL, Brad (Jackie) Dearing, of Bloomington, IL; three step-children, seven grandchildren, nine step-grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; husband; Clyde Dearing; brother Larry Eilks; sister, Marleen; son, Darin Dearing; and two grandsons, Tyler and Justin Dearing.

Mrs. Mangold attended church at Cherry Hills Church in Springfield, and she was a member of Bible Study Fellowship. She enjoyed going to the beach, working in the yard, spending time with family and friends, and talking about the Lord. She was a 1962 graduate of Harris High School in Petersburg. As a student, she worked at New Salem State Park's gift shop. And after high school, she was a legal secretary at Knuppel, Grosbell, Becker, & Tice in Petersburg, IL. She later worked at Country Companies (Springfield) as well as USDA-ASCS/FSA in both the Menard and Sangamon County offices and retired after 20 years.

Nancy was definitely a people-person. When she was around, there was

always fun. Laughter and joy seemed to spring up from her soul and spill-over onto all who were near. She lived well, loved deeply, and allowed God to beautifully mold her throughout her lifetime for His work.

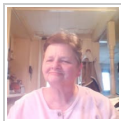
