Neil Bradley Huston - A loving Husband, Father, Brother, and Grandfather passed away on Thursday, July 31, 2025 at St. John's Hospital in Springfield at age 60.

Neil was born September 18, 1964 in Macomb, IL to Charles and Patricia (Blickenstaff) Huston. Neil is survived by his loving wife and soulmate Mary Jane (Masten) Huston. Neil and Mary Jane were married on November 2, 2019 at the First Baptist Church in Havana, IL.
