



## Ora Frazier

June 15, 1916 - April 14, 2014

Ora Nichols was born in Mexico (Audrain) County Missouri, June 15, 1916, the daughter of William Harvey and Edith (Edwards) Nichols. She died at Mason City Area Nursing home on Monday, April 14, 2014 at 9:23 p.m. A graduate of White Hall, IL High School Class of 1934, she married William Thomas Frazier in Jacksonville (Morgan County) IL, June 17, 1936. He died April 24, 2010.

During WWII, while her husband was overseas, she worked in the office of Ruckel's Pottery in White Hall, IL. Later she was the Deputy City Clerk of Jerseyville, IL, for several years.

Ora is survived by one daughter, Dr. Jane Frazier of Havana, IL, as well as several cousins and nieces. She was preceded in death by her parents, 2 brothers and two sisters.
