Patrick D Walker, 72, of Mason City, formerly of Eugene, Oregon, passed away Tuesday, January 31, 2017 at the Mason City Area Nursing Home. Pat was born May 31, 1944 to Doyle and Marcia (Borgelt) Walker in Peoria, Illinois. He married Carol Heald June 10, 1972, she preceded him in death August 2014.
