Paul Richard Jockisch Sr., 86, of Easton, passed away at St. John's Hospital on Thursday, April 23, 2015. He was born January 21, 1929 in Mason County, IL to Paul Larson and Beulah (VanEtten) Jockisch. He married Ida Marlene Fairow on December 9, 1951 in Kilbourne, and she preceded him in death on January 14, 2004. He married Eva Clark on June 5, 2005 and she survives.
