Phyllis Jean Roat, 83, of Havana, passed away at Mason District Hospital in Havana at 9:16 p.m. on Monday, January 13, 2014. She was born February 14, 1930 in Pekin, IL to Thomas and Ruth (Curtis) Frampton. She married John E. Roat on December 30, 1961 at the United Methodist Church in Pekin.

Mrs. Roat is survived by her husband, John, of Havana, son, Gordon (Lynne) Roat of Pekin, daughter, Gloria (Tony) Sanguedolce of Springfield, four grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. Also surviving are two sisters, Barbara (Harry) Monkman of Bloomington, IL, Doris (Jack) Kelley of Olathe, KS and sister-in-law Phyllis Frampton of Pekin. She was preceded in death by her parents, one daughter, Cynthia Ruth Roat and one brother, Kenneth Frampton.

Mrs. Roat was a member of the Havana Church of the Nazarene where she had served as Treasurer for 42 years and had also served on the Church Board and as a Sunday School teacher. She was a 1947 graduate of Pekin Community High School. She worked for Kreigsman Transfer in Pekin for 14 ½ years and later for the Havana Public Library for over a decade. Later, she was the bookkeeper for Roat Farms. She was a Mason County Election Judge for many years and was a member of the Farm Bureau Womens Committee. She acted as a 4-H leader and assisted the judging during 4-H Fair time. She was a member of YWCA in Pekin, serving on its board for 6

years and as treasurer for 4 years and of the neighborhood birthday club. She had a passion for crocheting doilies for friends and family.

Visitation will be held at her church from 4:00 until 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 16, 2014. Funeral services will be held on Friday, January 17, 2014 at 10:00 a.m., also at the church. Burial will follow the services at Laurel Hill Cemetery in Havana. Rev. Jim Buchanan will officiate.
