Richard "Dick" Donald Cheaney, 91, of Petersburg, passed away on Sunday, October 18, 2009, at 9:29 p.m., at Memorial Medical Center. He was born on February 9, 1918 in Petersburg to Donald and Helen Whiteneck Cheaney. He married Carol Stevens on September 22, 1940 in Greenview.
