



## Rodney Paul Laugel

January 13, 1944 - February 5, 2019

Rodney Paul Laugel, 75, of Mason City, passed away at St. John's Hospital in Springfield, IL at 9:20 a.m. on Tuesday, February 5, 2019. He was born January 13, 1944, in Effingham, IL, to Paul and Edna (Leffler) Laugel. He married Patricia Harris in Mason City on November 19, 2017.

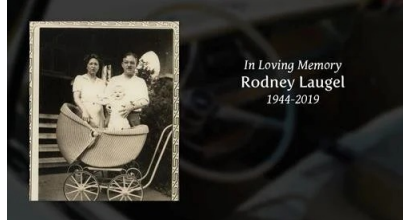

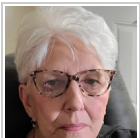
