



## Rosalyn Rita Tibbs

November 28, 1936 - September 19, 2009

Rosalyn Rita Tibbs, 72, of Easton, died on Saturday, September 19, 2009, at St. John's Hospital in Springfield.

She was born November 28, 1936 in rural Mason County, Illinois, the daughter of Edgar (Bud) and Marie Francis Siltman Welker. She married Allen George Tibbs on October 28, 1952 in Palmyra, Missouri.
