Rozena Ann (Pillsbury) Binger of Mason City, 96, passed away Thursday January 25, 2018 at Memorial Medical Center. She was born February 10, 1921 in the Sandridge Community, North of Petersburg, to Lyman A. and Olive E. (Thomson) Pillsbury. She married Moulton E. Binger on June 6, 1943 at the New Hope Baptist Church, just North of Petersburg.

Rozena is survived by: three daughters Myrna Binger Rutledge of Havana, Marla J. (Earl) Buro of Marietta, GA, and Marilee Tucker of Mason City; six grandchildren Julie Williams, Justin Rutledge, Grant Buro, Dyanna Motes, Megan Zwilling and Ryan Tucker; seven great grandchildren; and many cousins, nieces and nephews. She graduated from Memorial School of Nursing in 1942 and got her Post Graduate in Obstetrics in 1943 at Michael Reese Hospital in Chicago. She was an RN at Memorial Medical Center for more than 35 years. She also served as a Nurse at Boys' State Summer Camps in the 1970's where the boys affectionately called her Grandma Rosie. She was a dedicated nurse who always put her patients first. She was passionate about her vegetable and flower gardens and helped can a bounty of vegetables as recently as Sept. 2017. She loved to travel on bus tours and fly to visit family. She loved crafts and was once featured in the State Journal Register for her large Easter
