Rudolph Adolph Nordhausen, 93, of Havana, passed away at his home at 4:00 a.m. on Saturday, January 21, 2012. He was born September 18, 1918 in Bath, IL to John and Mary (Osing) Nordhausen. He married Lorraine Hahn at St. John's Lutheran Church in December 25, 1951.
