Russell Edison Weaver, 88, of Oakford , IL , died on Tuesday, January 9, 2007 at 4:30 pm at his residence. He was born on July 12, 1918 in Oakford to Bert and Grace Staley Weaver. He married Faye Gebhards on May 9, 1942 in Bobtown , IL .

He is survived by two daughters, Connie Gilboe Baker of Springfield, and Rebecca Roberts of Oakford; four sons, Russell (Sharon) Weaver of Florida, Randy (Julie) Weaver of Galesburg, Ron Weaver of Oakford, and Robert Weaver of Oakford; one sister, Betty Bower of Roodhouse; ten grandchildren; and four great grandchildren.

Mr. Weaver had been a member of the Clinton Lodge #19 AF & AM of Petersburg for 63 years. He was also a Shriner, a member of the Kiwanis club, and a member of the American Legion.. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force, having served during World War II.
