Sally Schulte Solliday, 71, of Jacksonville, passed away at 1:20 a.m. on Tuesday, September 08, 2009 at Barton W. Stone Nursing Home in Jacksonville. She was born October 16, 1937 in Peoria to Charles Herman and Margaret (Bollan) Schulte. She married John A. "Johnnye" Solliday on October 11, 1963. He survives.

Mrs. Solliday is survived by her husband, John of Jacksonville, one daughter, Sally Sue (Benoit) Lavigne of Beaufort, SC, and two grandchildren, Jean-Marc Lavigne and Margaret Lavigne. She acted as the Director of the Illinois School for the Deaf's Parent/Infant Institute from 1993 until 1998.
