

Theodore Orin Jackson

May 9, 1936 - March 20, 2018

Theodore Orin “Ted” Jackson, 81, of Havana, passed away at 9:55 a.m. at his home on Tuesday, March 20, 2018. He was born on May 9, 1936 in Pekin, IL to Jesse O. and Eva M. (Standard) Jackson. Ted married Sally Ann Smith, his high school sweetheart, on September 30, 1956. She preceded him in death on February 29, 2016.

During the years when he and Sally were raising their family, Ted worked first as a salesman/distributor for the 7-UP Company and then as a salesman for Rockford Life Insurance Company. After that, Ted worked as a self-employed general contractor before hiring on at the Havana Barge Terminal. He retired from Tabor Grain/ADM in 2001.

Ted was a member of the Havana Jaycees for several years and was active in scouting and little league with his son. He also was an avid supporter of his daughters throughout their involvement with the Havana High School Band.

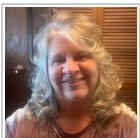
